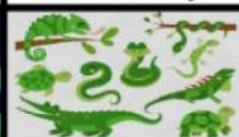

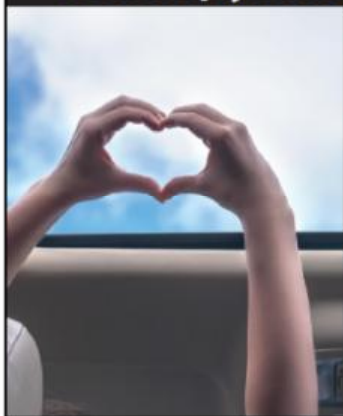

Balanced Eating in the Summer

Summer break is upon us and this sometimes leads to less structure around our eating habits. Children, especially those old enough to be alone, may not eat regular meals in the day but prefer to snack or “graze” on whatever they can find. Often convenience foods are the stand by for quick meals for independent eaters home alone. These food items tend to be high in saturated fat, low in fibre and lacking variety.

What to have instead...

Balance is key! It can be helpful for parents to have a variety of food items available to provide long lasting energy, good sources of vitamins and minerals, as well as tasty and easy to prepare for young chefs. Try making a list of simple snack and meal ideas kids can create on their own and have these listed for reference in the summer. Also, it may be wise to spend some time in the evening or weekend prepping items to have on hand for when they are home alone during the day.

Final Message...

As parents, we have to provide children with the tools and knowledge to help them make their own balanced meals as they become more independent. This will give them a jump start to healthy eating as they grow into adults.

Batch Cooking to the Rescue...

Batch cooking means making a large amount of a meal or food and freezing portions for later use. This can be a great option for kids home alone as they can just “heat and eat”. Soups, stews, muffins, breakfast burritos, casseroles, egg cups, waffles and pancakes can all be frozen and re-heated as needed.

Homemade Whole Fruit Popsicles

How to Make Homemade Whole Fruit Popsicles

These whole fruit popsicles are as easy as 1-2-3!

As a kid, we'd fill up our popsicle molds with sodas and other sugary juice from the fridge. While these fruit popsicles require an extra step or two, it is SO worth it and healthier by-far.

Directions:

Prepare the fruit by chopping it up into small, bite-sized pieces. The fruit should easily fit in the popsicle molds without being smushed.

Pack the molds with your mixed fruit until they are about 80% full. Fill in any large gaps with blueberries or other small pieces of fruit.

Pour apple juice, water, or your juice of choice into each mold. Make sure to leave about a half of an inch at the top to prevent spilling.

If your mold requires popsicle sticks, insert them now. Be sure not to push in the sticks too far so they are easy to hold onto.

Freeze until solid, at least 2-3 hours. If the popsicles won't budge when you're ready to eat them, place the mold in a warm water bath for a few minutes until they can wiggle free. Be careful not to pull the sticks out!

Enjoy your popsicles right away or store them in the freezer until you're ready to eat them.

Please note: They can be stored in the freezer for up to 3 months.

- 2 kiwis sliced
- 1 cup canteloupe chopped small
- 1 cup strawberries halved or quartered
- 1 cup blueberries
- 2 cups organic fruit juice or water

HOW TO STAY SAFE IN THE SUN

Enjoy the sunny days while staying safe and protected!



Always wear sunscreen.



Apply sunscreen with SPF 30 or higher at least 15 minutes before going out. Reapply often.

Wear protective clothing.



Cover up when out in the sunshine. Put on a hat to protect your face and neck.

Wear sunglasses.



Keep your eyes protected with sunglasses that are designed to block UV rays.

Don't stay out in the sun too long.



Limit your time in the sun, especially between 11 AM and 3 PM. Seek shade if you can.

Weather



Our skin can burn even if it's cloudy! Apply sunscreen to protect your skin.

Splish, Splash



Water washes sunscreen off. Sunscreen should be reapplied straight after you have been in water.
